The Sussex County Commissioners approved the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (SCMUA) endorsement of Diamond Chip Realty's WQMP.



The Diamond Chip Realty WQMP resolution was not on the public's agenda prior to the commissioners' vote.

Commissioner Carney did not recuse himself. Commissioner DeGroot was the only No Vote. 3/28/24



The Court ruled in the DCR vs Sparta Planning Board case. The ruling is partially in favor of Diamond Chip Realty finding that 8 of the 11 Planning Board members are conflicted because they are "members" of Sparta Responsible Development and because SRD was created to object to the Mega Warehouse application.

Hearings will resume in 45 Days.
